
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
*Due to a work conference at the start of February, school visits were less this month.

Lesson 4

RESPONDING TO PRESSURE

DIRECTIONS: Define, Assess, and Respond to the following situations. Remember to think of the positive and negative consequences when you assess the situations.

Situation 1

Oscar saw his best friend take money off the teacher's desk. His friend said it was only \$5.00 and the teacher probably wouldn't notice. Oscar's friend threatened to say that Oscar stole the money if he told.

DEFINE Oscar's best friend took money from the teacher's desk.

ASSESS #1 - Say nothing. #2 - Tell the teacher.

#3 - Talk to the friend about returning the money.

RESPOND Have the friend return the money because it's the right thing to do. How would the friend feel if someone stole money from them?

Working through peer pressure from Lesson #4.

What might YOU do to help you pause in a stressful situation?

- Count to 5 and slow things down.
- Walk away from the situation to give yourself time to calm down.
- Tell yourself you can do it (positive self talk).
- Put your head down on the desk.

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2. Stranger Awareness (4 presentations)

On February 26th, I attended Covenant Christian School with CPO De Boer and presented to grades K, 1, 3, and 4 on Stranger Awareness. For the younger grades, a book called “What if a Stranger Approaches You?” by Anara Guard was read, which outlined 8 safety tips for dealing with a stranger. Following the book reading, students practiced how to yell “no!” at a stranger before running to a trusted adult.

For the older grades, a slideshow was developed that talked about what to do in different situations, including what to do if an adult that you don’t know asked for your address or phone number.

- Don't take a ride! Always ask your parents before taking a ride from anyone.


