REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS

All new families are to register their child(ren) online via PowerSchool Registration which is available on the Black Gold School Division website at: [New Student Registration](#)

Parents will be emailed between August 25-27 to confirm their child's registration and share any other pertinent information.

RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2020-2021 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2021-2022 are automatically registered for the 2021-2022 school year.

All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2021-2022 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.

CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDING IN-SCHOOL CLASSES OR DISTANCE LEARNING

On August 3, 2021, all parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger to confirm the choice of learning for each child. If the parents/guardians wish to change the choice of learning, instructions on how to do this will be included. All change requests must be submitted by August 13, 2021.

SCHOOL START DATE & TIMES FOR GRADES 1 - 12 STUDENTS

First Day of School (Full Day): Staggered Entry as follows:

Monday, August 30: Grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11 only

Tuesday, August 31: Grades 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 only

Wednesday, September 1: All Gr 1-12 students attend & regular classes begin.

(Contact school if child can't attend on above assigned day but will begin on September 1.)

EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES (ECS): KINDERGARTEN & PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS

KINDERGARTEN:

Leduc Estates offers half day kindergarten every school day. There are 2 programs running in the morning, one with English programming and one with French immersion programming. Both classes run from 8:30 am to 11:20 am.

Staggered entry: August 30, 31, September 1st, and 2nd, 2021. Parents will be contacted by the teacher in late August regarding the staggered entry schedule.

Regular Classes commence: September 3rd, 2021.

Supply lists were distributed with the ECS Information Package that was distributed in June. New registrants can pick up this package at the school office beginning August 25th or access the [supply lists online](#) on the school website.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN:

Pre-kindergarten is offered at École Bellevue School, East Elementary School, Linsford Park School, Calmar Elementary School, Thorsby Elementary School and Robina Baker Elementary School. Only children who qualify for ECS programming due to a delay or diagnosis as per Alberta Education criteria are eligible. Please contact Niki Gill at niki.gill@blackgold.ca to inquire about eligibility.

To ensure a balance of strengths and needs across all programs, program times will be communicated directly by the school to all eligible families in September once school staff have had the opportunity to meet all the children in person and perform any necessary assessments.
