REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS

RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2022-2023 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2023-2024 are automatically registered for the 2023-2024 school year.

All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2023-2024 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.

EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES (ECS): KINDERGARTEN & PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS

KINDERGARTEN:

English Program and French Program is Monday through Friday mornings 8:33 am to 11:20 am.

The first few days of kindergarten will be staggered entry for students. The staggered entry days will be August 30, 31 and September 1st. On September 5th, all kindergarten students will attend kindergarten together in their respective classes. Your child will be receiving a welcome letter from his/her teacher in the beginning of August. This letter will include which **one** of the 3 days will be your child's staggered entry day.

Early Intervention Program (EIP) - Pre-Kindergarten:

Early Intervention Program (EIP) - Pre-Kindergarten is offered at Calmar Elementary School, École Bellevue School, École Corinthia Park School, Linsford Park School, Robina Baker Elementary School, and Thorsby Elementary School. Only children who qualify for Early Intervention programming due to a delay or diagnosis as per Alberta Education criteria are eligible. Children may qualify as early as two years eight months by August 31st of the respective school year if they meet the criteria. Please go to https://www.blackgold.ca/schools/programs/pre-kindergarten/ to enter intake for free eligibility screening.

English as a Second Language (ESL) Junior Kindergarten Program:

The ESL Junior Kindergarten program is a half-day program, four days a week, led by a certified teacher with an Education Assistant at École Dansereau Meadows School. Only children three years and eight months by August 31st of the respective school year and whose main language at home is not English are eligible. Please go to https://www.blackgold.ca/esl-junior-kindergarten/

to enter intake for free eligibility screening.

To ensure a balance of strengths and needs across all programs, program times will be communicated directly by the school to all eligible families in September once school staff have had the opportunity to meet all the children in person and perform any necessary assessments.
