#### **ÉLES IS NUT AWARE**

If no one in a classroom has a peanut allergy, peanut products are allowed. However, if a student has a peanut allergy, his/her classroom is designated as a "Nut Aware" classroom. In "Nut Aware" classrooms, families are discouraged from bringing peanut products to school, a "Nut Aware Classroom" sign is posted on the door; teachers, parents, & students work together to develop a reasonable & appropriate plan.

# reasonable & appropriate plan. Feeling Sick? AHS says...

**Respiratory Illness:** Stay home until all symptoms have improved, feeling well enough to resume normal activities, and be fever-free for 24 hours without using fever-reducing medications.

**Gastrointestinal Illness:** Stay home until 48 hours after all symptoms have resolved.

**Rash Illness**: Stay home for the length of time recommended by the AHS Public Health Outbreak Team.

## **Visitors & Volunteers**

We appreciate all visitors and volunteers at ÉLES. A reminder that you will need to sign in at the office computer prior to going anywhere in the school. This will ensure the safety of everyone. Thank you for your cooperation.

\*\*Note, if your child(ren) are late for school, they will also need to check in at the office.

For pickup/drop off during school hours, you are required to sign your child in/out on the comupter in the office or online at the ÉLES website under the Parents tab, then sign in/sign out.

## **Drop off & Pick up**

Staff supervision of students begins at 8:20 and ends at 3:15. Parents can drop off and pick up children using the Kiss and Go at the front of the school. A reminder that parents are not to park or vacate vehicles while in the Kiss and Go zone.

If your child requires support to vacate the vehicle, please park on William Bell Drive or use the parking lot at Aileen Faller Park and walk with your child.

#### Here's how to get started...

- Enter Access Code 2023HL
- Complete the rest of the registration form
- Click the Register Now button at the bottom
- To add your child(ren), click on STUDENTS
- Follow the instructions to add a child in your family who attends École Leduc Estates School. There is a drop down menu under CLASS to select your child's teacher. To add additional children, scroll to bottom to ADD NEW
- Once your child(ren) have been added, proceed to Orders to choose hot lunch for your child(ren) on September 5th when orders open.

#### **Payments:**

We only accept hot lunch order payments through Bambora. No cheque or cash payments will be accepted at any time.

The hot lunch online order system requires a small amount of setup time at the beginning as you must register each child you have attending our school prior to ordering hot lunch. Once the initial setup process is complete, your hot lunch orders for the remainder of the year should be quick and simple.
