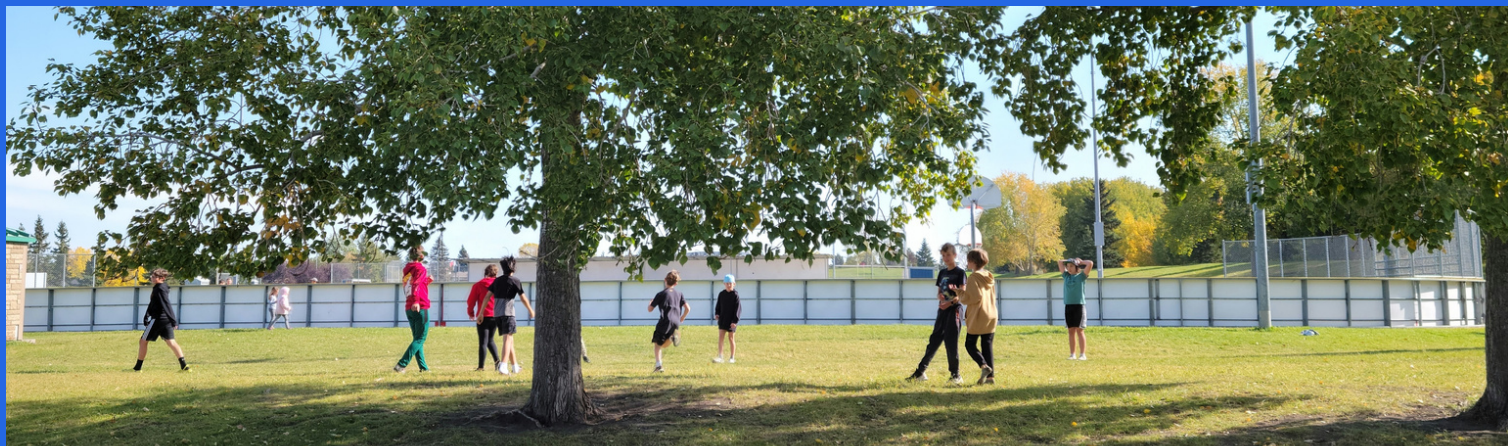

ÉLES IS NUT AWARE

If no one in a classroom has a peanut allergy, peanut products are allowed. However, if a student has a peanut allergy, his/her classroom is designated as a "Nut Aware" classroom. In "Nut Aware" classrooms, families are discouraged from bringing peanut products to school, a "Nut Aware Classroom" sign is posted on the door; teachers, parents, & students work together to develop a reasonable & appropriate plan.



Feeling Sick? AHS says...

Respiratory illness: Stay home until all symptoms have improved, feeling well enough to resume normal activities, and be fever-free for 24 hours without using fever-reducing medications.

Gastrointestinal illness: Stay home until 48 hours after all symptoms have resolved.

Rash illness: Stay home for the length of time recommended by the AHS Public Health Outbreak Team.
